- New registration platforms for the 2021/22 seasons!
- USSSA has partnered with GotSport to allow current GotSoccer and GotSport clients to fully integrate into the USSSA system during their own registration process.
- For teams, clubs, leagues and organizations not using GotSport in 2021/22, the SDS system will be the registration platform for reporting player, coach, and team data to USSSA.
- As we will operate in two registration systems this year, USSSA will allow each member to decide which system best fits their needs.
