The tournament is held in Northern Ireland and players need to be available to depart the U.S. no later than July 19th and return no sooner than July 27th

Program Itinerary July 19 - 27, 2024

Depart from U.S. Gateway on July 19th with July 20th arrival at Dublin Int. Airport. Transfer to Belfast area for check in to accommodation and light training session.

Morning training session or friendly game on July 21st and then take part in Opening Ceremony.

Tournament play begins July 22nd through July 26th. When not playing in tournament games, sightseeing and other event programming is organized for players.

Transfers begin July 27th to Dublin Int. Airport and return to the United States.

Program Exclusions: Airline flights to and from United States, uniform packet, passport fees, and additional spending money or sightseeing not included in the program.

Gateway departure cities will be communicated to all players, and family/friend travelers where they will be met by a USSSA staff member.

A payment plan will be created for all travelers. A deposit is required to secure your spot and we then issue a plan for payment by July 5th.

Each team will have one head coach, one assisting coach, and we will have one program director who oversees the teams during their time at SuperNICup.

All player accommodation is together in tournament housing supervised by tournament staff and our staff.
